

PRIVACY POLICY

Divine Initiative Ministries, LLC, a Florida limited liability company (“DIM”) values your trust in our company. Our privacy policy below (“Privacy Policy”) addresses our data collection and retention, use of such information, and our disclosure practices. The words “we” or “our” or “us” in this Privacy Policy refer to DIM. The words “you” or “your” refer below to each person who accesses or uses our website at www.divinitiative.org (“website”).

1. Your personal information, which makes you unique and identifiable, is collected when you register online, submit inquiries to us, or use our services. Your personal information will be used by us to address your inquiries, to provide our services, and to help us better communicate with you. We may require you to complete an online registration and create a password (that you should not share with anyone) for the services we offer. Non-personal information, which is information that cannot distinguish one person from another, will be used by us for any lawful purpose. We collect information through your browser or device, by using certain internet tracking technology. We may disclose your personal information to our affiliates, related companies, and third party service providers who may service our website, analyze your personal preferences and how you use this website, to improve your website experience, to handle inquiries, and for customer service. You consent to our use, collection, storage, retention, and disclosure of your information, subject to the terms contained in this Privacy Policy, by accessing our website and sending information to us. We will not sell or lease your personal information to anyone.

We follow commercially reasonable practices to protect your personal identifiable information, but we make no representation, warranty or guarantee that our safeguards will always work to protect your personal information from unauthorized access. Consequently, the DIM Group [identified in our Website Terms of Use (“Website Terms”)] shall not be liable for any third party data theft or security breach.

3. Do not send to our website, or upload or post on our website, any confidential or other proprietary information that you or someone else owns, or any malware that could affect our website’s ability to operate or function according to our specifications. All information that you send us, except your personal information, will be assumed to be non-private and usable without any compensation or royalty due to anyone.

4. We will fully cooperate with law enforcement, governmental agencies, or in any legal proceeding, when requested for information about any person who accesses or uses our website.

5. This Privacy Policy is an important part of our Website Terms. All rights, remedies, indemnification, and other legal protection, that are reserved or expressly provided to the DIM Group under our Website Terms, shall further apply to this Privacy Policy and benefit the DIM Group, and are an important part of this Privacy Policy. We cannot waive any part of this Privacy Policy by our action or omission. If any part of this Privacy Policy is unenforceable or unlawful, that part will be severed and the rest shall remain in effect. This Privacy Policy may be amended or replaced at any time, without notice, and any change will automatically become effective when we post an updated version on our website. Your subsequent access or use of our website, following an amendment to this Privacy Policy, automatically binds you to our Privacy Policy, as amended, and satisfies any legal requirement that an agreement must be in writing and signed to be binding. If there is any conflict between this Privacy Policy and the Website Terms, the Website Terms shall always control. The governing language for this Privacy Policy is English. If this Privacy Policy is translated into other languages, the English version shall always control.

6. You may obtain, correct or limit the personal information that we may store about you. You may also notify us to delete your personal information, except when we must comply with applicable record retention laws. California residents may additionally request and obtain information about any disclosure of personal identifiable information to third parties for direct marketing purposes.
